## **The Learning Club**

The Learning Club is an El Morro after-school program that targets children in grades 2 through 5 who are at-risk for grade retention. Students are teacher referred. The Learning Club is staffed by trained volunteers who care about children and is under the direction of two teachers. ***If you have 1 to 2 hours a week to give to a child and his or her education, become a TLC Volunteer.***

Students meet with volunteers on campus twice a week. For maximum learning, the student-volunteer ratio is one on one and no more than two to one. Students must bring work from the teacher for admission to TLC. Membership is also contingent upon appropriate student behavior.
